## Genesis 23:1-11

## SARAH'S BURIAL

23 Now Sarah lived 127 years; these were all the years of her life. ${ }^{2}$ Sarah died in Kiriath-arba (that is, Hebron) in the land of Canaan, and Abraham went to mourn for Sarah and to weep for her.
${ }^{3}$ Then Abraham got up from beside his dead wife and spoke to the Hethites: 4 " am an alien residing among you. Give me burial property among you so that I can bury my dead.",m
${ }^{5}$ The Hethites replied to Abraham, 6 "Listen to us, my lord. You are a prince of God among us. Bury your dead in our finest burial place. None of us will withhold from you his burial place for burying your dead."
7 Then Abraham rose and bowed down to the Hethites, the people of the land. ${ }^{8} \mathrm{He}$ said to them, "If you are willing for me to bury my dead, listen to me and ask Ephron son of Zohar on my behalf 9 to give me the cave of Machpelah that belongs to him; it is at the end
of his field. Let him give it to me in your presence, for the full price, as burial property."
${ }^{10}$ Ephron was sitting among the Hethites. So in the hearing of all the Hethites who came to the gate of his city, Ephron the Hethite answered Abraham: ${ }^{11}$ "No, my lord. Listen to me. I give you the field, and I give you the cave that is in it. I give it to you in the sight of my people. Bury your dead."
