## **Acts 14:21-28**

### **CHURCH PLANTING**

**14** <sup>21</sup> After they had preached the gospel in that town and made many disciples, they returned to Lystra, to Iconium, and to Antioch, <sup>22</sup> strengthening the disciples by encouraging them to continue in the faith and by telling them, “It is necessary to go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God.” <sup>23</sup> When they had appointed elders for them in every church and prayed with fasting, they committed them to the Lord in whom they had believed.

<sup>24</sup> They passed through Pisidia and came to Pamphylia. <sup>25</sup> After they had spoken the word in Perga, they went down to Attalia. <sup>26</sup> From there they sailed back to Antioch where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work they had now completed. <sup>27</sup> After they arrived and gathered the church together, they reported everything God had done with them and that he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles. <sup>28</sup> And they spent a considerable time with the disciples.
