## **Acts 25:1-5**

### **APPEAL TO CAESAR**

**25** Three days after Festus arrived in the province, he went up to Jerusalem from Caesarea. <sup>2</sup> The chief priests and the leaders of the Jews presented their case against Paul to him; and they appealed, <sup>3</sup> asking for a favor against Paul, that Festus summon him to Jerusalem. They were, in fact, preparing an ambush along the road to kill him. <sup>4</sup> Festus, however, answered that Paul should be kept at Caesarea, and that he himself was about to go there shortly. <sup>5</sup> “Therefore,” he said, “let those of you who have authority go down with me and accuse him, if he has done anything wrong.”
