#### 2 PETER 2:4-11

#### THE JUDGMENT OF FALSE TEACHERS

**2** <sup>4</sup> For if God didn't spare the angels who sinned but cast them into hell and delivered them in chains of utter darkness to be kept for judgment; <sup>5</sup> and if he didn't spare the ancient world, but protected Noah, a preacher of righteousness, and seven others, when he brought the flood on the world of the ungodly; <sup>6</sup> and if he reduced the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to ashes and condemned them to extinction, making them an example of what is coming to the ungodly; <sup>7</sup> and if he rescued righteous Lot, distressed by the depraved behavior of the immoral <sup>8</sup> (for as that righteous man lived among them day by day, his righteous soul was tormented by the lawless deeds he saw and heard)—<sup>9</sup> then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment, <sup>10</sup> especially those who follow the polluting desires of the flesh and despise authority.

Bold, arrogant people! They are not afraid to slander the glorious ones; <sup>11</sup> however, angels, who are greater in might and power, do not bring a slanderous charge against them before the Lord.
