## SUNDAY SCHOOL READING PLAN

### **MATTHEW 10:5-15**

#### **COMMISSIONING THE TWELVE**

**10** <sup>5</sup> Jesus sent out these twelve after giving them instructions: “Don’t take the road that leads to the Gentiles, and don’t enter any Samaritan town. <sup>6</sup> Instead, go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. <sup>7</sup> As you go, proclaim: ‘The kingdom of heaven has come near.’ <sup>8</sup> Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you received, freely give. <sup>9</sup> Don’t acquire gold, silver, or copper for your money-belts. <sup>10</sup> Don’t take a traveling bag for the road, or an extra shirt, sandals, or a staff, for the worker is worthy of his food. <sup>11</sup> When you enter any town or village, find out who is worthy, and stay there until you leave. <sup>12</sup> Greet a household when you enter it, <sup>13</sup> and if the household is worthy, let your peace be on it; but if it is unworthy, let your peace return to you. <sup>14</sup> If anyone does not welcome you or listen to your words, shake the dust off your feet when you leave that house or town. <sup>15</sup> Truly I tell you, it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah than for that town.
