### THE SADDUCEES AND THE RESURRECTION

**22** <sup>23</sup> That same day some Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came up to him and questioned him: <sup>24</sup> “Teacher, Moses said, **if a man dies, having no children, his brother is to marry his wife and raise up offspring for his brother.** <sup>25</sup> Now there were seven brothers among us. The first got married and died. Having no offspring, he left his wife to his brother. <sup>26</sup> The same thing happened to the second also, and the third, and so on to all seven. <sup>27</sup> Last of all, the woman died. <sup>28</sup> In the resurrection, then, whose wife will she be of the seven? For they all had married her.”

<sup>29</sup> Jesus answered them, “You are mistaken, because you don’t know the Scriptures or the power of God. <sup>30</sup> For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage but are like angels in heaven. <sup>31</sup> Now concerning the resurrection of the dead, haven’t you read what was spoken to you by God: <sup>32</sup> **I am the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob?** He is not the God of the dead, but of the living.”

<sup>33</sup> And when the crowds heard this, they were astonished at his teaching.
